> ten, six, and two minutes prior <

QST QST QST. For all hams monitoring this frequency, the City of Orem will be holding an emergency net for the Orem City Drill in about ten (or etc.) minutes. Please stand by and keep this channel open for further announcements. This is only a drill, not an actual emergency. KØWPI controlling.

Calling an Orem City NW Quadrant net. Calling an Orem City NW Quadrant net. I'm Joe Blow, KØWPI, net control for the City of Orem, NW quadrant, which includes the following areas (read off the areas in your quadrant) (*an area is defined by LDS stake boundaries*):

Please stand by, and in sixty seconds I'll ask for check-ins and reports from all areas in the NW quadrant. This is KØWPI controlling.

> pause for 60 seconds <

This is Joe Blow, KØWPI, net control for the City of Orem, NW quadrant. Let's go ahead and take check-ins at this time. Please state your call sign slowly and phonetically, and state whether you have traffic, which should contain your name, your area, and your report. Go ahead and call now.

> pause for check-ins : there might not be a big response just yet, but at least you've made your presence known <

> etc. <

> **If you have any traffic, please pass it on to the City Net (145.770 MHz simplex) ASAP <**

> repeat from the start every ten or fifteen minutes <

> please remain as quadrant NCS until the City NCS releases you <

> when the City NCS releases you, say <

We'll now bring this quadrant net to a close. Thanks to everybody for your time and support. We're now returning this frequency to normal use. 7-3. This is KØWPI.
